Clean air is important both for the engine in your F350 and for the passengers inside the truck. The Ford F350 is equipped with a cabin air filter that cleans the dust and particles out of the air coming into the truck through the HVAC system. Step 1 - Remove old cabin air filter. Look under the glove box and you'll find the plastic box that holds the cabin air filter. The 1st and 2nd gen Mini Coopers have a slightly different box and cabin air filter, but the process for removal is the same for both.

The cabin air filter in a 2005 GMC is responsible for keeping the ventilation system free of harmful air contaminants and particles. A dirty air filter is not able to effectively protect the air system from dangerous fumes. When the air filter is clogged with dirt and build-up, air cannot flow freely through the vents.
